of the Illustrious Grand Master. The Festival will include a special presentation of the Super Excellent Master Degree.

The Order of the Temple will begin at 1:00 PM. Light breakfast and lunch will be served on both days.

the Sioux City Musuem, the Art Center, and the Queen of Peace; or to simply relax at the Temple. Driving directions will be available to the sites.

The Illustrious Grand Master's Reception and Zadok's Centennial Banquet will take place on Saturday, Oct 10. Menu will include Prime Rib, potato, vegetable, dessert and appropriate beverages for only \$25.
